LONG-TERM MINISTRIES:

1. Team members for church planting and development in urban and rural settings (Skills such as Theological Education by Extension, evangelism, discipleship, leadership training, music, children’s and youth ministry, counseling)
2. People with a heart/vision to evangelize Native and Hispanic people of all ages (but specifically university and college students and other young adults), especially:
 - a. In new Canada ministries in Prince George, Fort St. James, Burns Lake, Houston, Smithers, Terrace, Prince Rupert, Haida Gwaii (Queen Charlotte Islands)
 - b. In almost any U.S. city with a significant population of Native and/or Hispanic young adults (such as California [17 Native reservations in southern CA alone]; Arizona [including Navajos, Hopis, and Apaches, many more]; Oklahoma; Texas; New Mexico [including Zuni and other Pueblo tribes]; Colorado [including Utes]; Nevada; Oregon; Washington; Montana; Bemidji [three nearby reservations and a Native Bible college] and Minneapolis, Minnesota; Green Bay, Wisconsin; South Dakota; Chicago, IL;)
 - c. In Mexico cities of Guadalajara, Jalisco; León, Guanajuato; Chihuahua City, Chihuahua; and Oaxaca City, Oaxaca.



OTHER LONG- & SHORT-TERM MINISTRIES (Career/partnership/internship)

1. People to serve on church development teams and in specific areas such as ESL (English as Second Language), aviation, camping, sports ministry, communication, translation, pastoral studies, urban and rural ministries.
2. Technology Skilled services (coupled with church development)
 - a. Ministry services and resource development: Skills in accounting; posting and receipting donations; mailing/postal services; graphic design, printing/copying; secretarial; computer and computer repair; social media tools, website design, electronic media tools and devices; stewardship representation; promotional non-profit marketing (audio, visual, and printed materials); or grounds maintenance

- b. Publication services: Skills in computer programming and repair, web design, editing/writing, graphic arts, photography, or promotion
- c. Aviation: A heart for evangelism, discipleship, and church planting plus skills as pilot/mechanic; airframe/power plant; business manager/administrative skills; ministry coordinator/flight coordinator/or dispatcher; promotion/recruitment; or ESL teachers (Tucson, AZ, and Chihuahua City and Durango City, Mexico)
- d. Automotive services: ASE-certified auto technicians.



SHORT-TERM MINISTRIES:

1. Urban/village/reservation focus: Teams or individuals to serve with Native churches
2. Broken Arrow Bible Ranch (Gallup, NM): Camp counselors and staff, including maintenance, cooks and kitchen helpers; year-round ministry opportunities
3. Rock Nest Ranch (Houston, B.C.): Summer maintenance; summer program director; camp counselors and staff; year-round construction opportunities
4. Alpha & Omega Youth Camp (Mexico): evangelism, discipleship, music, children's and youth ministry, counseling (Spanish language required)
5. Wilderness Trails program (Canada): One couple or two singles with skill and training in wilderness camping, survival, first aid, and youth ministry.
